AGRICULTURAL PATROL SECTION CELL PHONES

As an enhanced service to the members of the South Miami-Dade agricultural community, the Miami-Dade Police Department's South Regional Agricultural Patrol Section maintains cell phones for each of the three shift supervisors and designated duty officers. Those telephone numbers are as follows:

MIDNIGHT SQUAD (10 p.m. - 6 a.m.)

Supervisor (M-F) (786) 218-8300
Duty Officer (7 days) (786) 218-8301

DAY SQUAD (6 a.m. - 2 p.m.)

Supervisor (M-F) (786) 295-1822
Duty Officer (7 days) (786) 218-8344

AFTERNOON SQUAD (2 p.m. - 10 p.m.)

Supervisor (M-F) (786) 351-7613
Duty Officer (7 days) (786) 258-2224

These phones can be used to contact officers or supervisors with requests, information, or other matters not of immediate concern, such as property crimes discovered after the fact, in which the subjects had previously fled the crime scene. ***However, in the event an immediate police response is necessary***, such as in-progress crimes, other emergencies, disturbances, or other significant matters, citizens are urged to contact the following telephone numbers, which are staffed 24-7 with operators **prior to attempting to contact an Agricultural Patrol officer or supervisor:**

NON EMERGENCIES (DISTURBANCES, ASSAULTS, ETC.): (305) 476-5423

Once an incident is reported to a police complaint officer at one of the above listed numbers, persons are encouraged to attempt contact with the on-duty officer or supervisor to advise them of the situation. As cell phone performance is contingent on the location of towers and other conditions, citizens are further encouraged to leave a voice mail message should cell phone contact with our staff not be made.
