The Wayne Dunagan Memorial Scholarship was established in 2005 by the Dade County Farm Bureau to recognize outstanding academic and civic achievement. Qualifications for applicants are as follows:

- Minimum 3.0 GPA
- Financial need
- Academic achievement
- Demonstrated leadership in civic and social clubs
- Plans to pursuing a career in agriculture

This scholarship is open to college undergraduates only. Applicants must be a resident of Miami-Dade County, however, applicants can be enrolled in a university outside of Miami-Dade County.

Scholarship is \$500. All applications must be accompanied by a sealed transcript and two letters of recommendation. Applications must be received by Thursday, February 1, 2007 at 5 p.m.
